



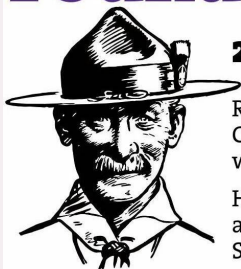

ON FOUNDER'S DAY - 22 FEBRUARY, 2026

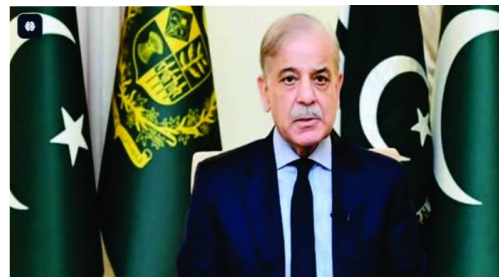


Dear Scouts,

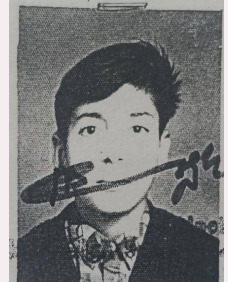


approaching the mosque with the gun fire and intent to terrorist attack. Scout Aon

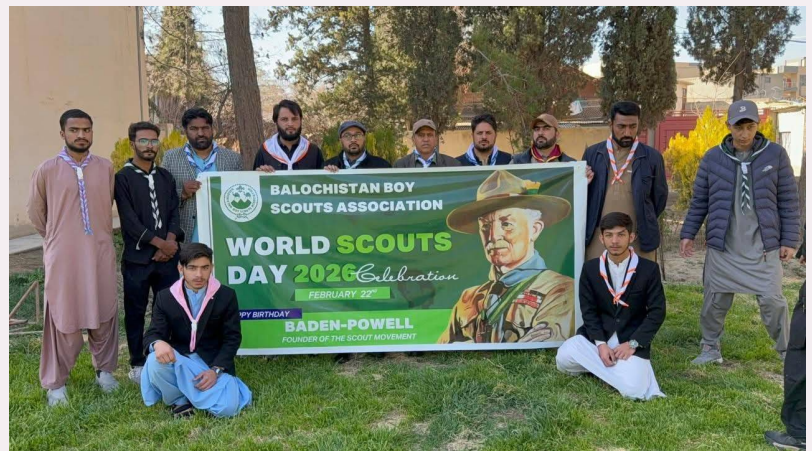
Iftar Dastarkhwan

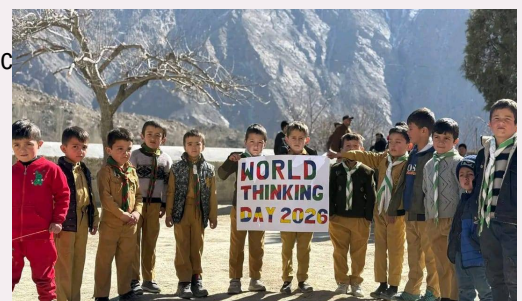

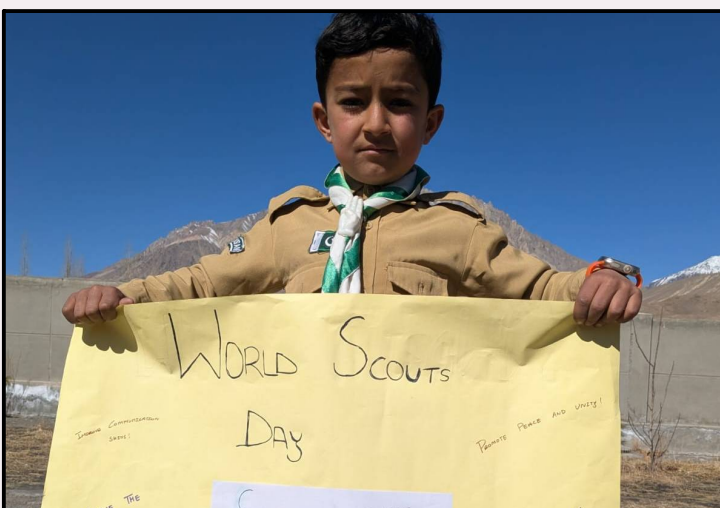
